Dear Warren County High Families,

I wanted to make you aware of the changes effective this school year in regards to promotion and graduation requirements. As we transition from year-long courses to semester courses, we must adapt our policy in requirements for our students. As we move forward, rest assured that we will work diligently to ensure that all of our current graduating seniors have the necessary credits. We will work with any specific issues on a case-by-case basis.

Promotion and Graduation Requirements Effective 2017 – 2018

Freshman and future graduation cohorts will be required to obtain 28 credits in order to graduate. The sophomore, junior, and senior class, will have a staggered increase of credits from the previous 24 credits. The chart below shows the specific credits per grade level:

Current Class Level	Graduation Credits
Seniors	25 credits
Juniors	26 credits
Sophomores	27 credits
Freshman & all incoming cohorts	28 credits

Students will still be required to receive the traditional specific course credit in regards to English, Math, Science, History, Health/PE, and electives.

The promotion requirements will be as follows:

Promotion to grade 10	5 credits
Promotion to grade 11	12 credits
Promotion to grade 12	20 credits
