**NC GENERAL STATUTE 110-91(1)  
Requirement for Child’s Health Assessment**

Each child shall have a health assessment before being admitted or within 30 days following admission to a child care center. The assessment must be completed and signed by one of the following:

- A licensed physician
- The physician’s authorized agent who is currently approved by the North Carolina Medical Board, or comparable certifying board in any state contiguous to North Carolina
- A certified nurse practitioner
- A public health nurse meeting the Department’s Standards for Early Periodic Screening, Diagnosis, and Treatment Program

**NC GENERAL STATUTE 110-91(1)  
Requirement for Immunization Records**

Each child must have a record of immunization on file at the center within 30 days of enrollment. A current immunization record must be on file for each child. Each time a child receives an immunization, the record must be updated.

3. We urge you to comply with the law. **Your child may return to school as soon as the required certificate of immunization and health assessment forms are given to the principal.**
